### What are cookies?

Cookies are text files that our website sends to the browser or to your device from which you view our website (for example, phone, tablet, computer). They allow us to recognize you and customize our website accordingly, analyze your behavior, display certain content, and more. We write more about individual cookies below.

### What types of cookies do we use?

**Necessary** - functional, technical, security - these are necessary in order for us to safely display the website and our services to function as they should or to know that you have (not) given us consent to the processing of cookies, etc.

**Analytical** - these help us to analyze how the website works in terms of visitor behavior and to adapt and change the website accordingly.

**Preferences** - these cookies are used to display the content in the settings you prefer - for example, in a certain language or otherwise make it easier for you to view / use our services.

**Marketing** - thanks to these cookies, we or third parties can customize the offer of our services after your visit. You may then see this offer outside of our website.

You can find specific cookies and more detailed information about them directly in the table at the end of this document.

### On what basis do we process cookies?

We can work with **technical, security and functional cookies** on the basis of legal regulations. Without them, we would not be able to provide you with our services safely and correctly.

We may process **analytical, preferential and marketing** cookies based on your consent. You will prevent this processing by not giving us your consent, then by setting up a browser, using the cookie bar settings or browsing in incognito mode.

## How can I prevent the use of cookies?

First of all, we would like to state that cookies, which we collect for the purpose of measuring website traffic and generating statistics regarding traffic and behavior of visitors on the website, are assessed in the form of a bulk unit and thus in a form that does not allow us to identify individuals. Cookies necessary for the functionality of the website are always kept only for the time strictly necessary for its functioning.
